Life assurance medicine is changing in parallel with the development of medical science and is influenced by economic and social factors. For those from all over the world who are involved in life assurance medicine the 17th ICLAM Congress offers an unparalleled opportunity for an update on recent medical advances which is reflected in the Scientific Program.

The Scientific Committee is chaired by Professor R. D. Rubens, M.D., F.R.C.P., Guy's Hospital, London. Noteworthy speakers will address topics in respiratory medicine, cardiology, neurology, gastroenterology, nephrology, oncology and disability. Of particular contemporary interest will be discussions of cardiomyopathies, chronic fatigue syndrome, renal and bone marrow transplantation and AIDS. Category I Continuing Medical Education credit of 12 hours will be available to participants.

The Social Program is of equal quality and includes outstanding events for delegates and guests. All attendees will enjoy a reception at the Natural History Museum hosted by Her Majesty's Government, a classical concert, a formal banquet and a choice of excursions.

The latter include a visit to Windsor Castle and Eton or Harrow College, or a tour to Leeds Castle and the Kentish country side with lunch in one of Kent's several famous Oast-houses, or visits to several Oxford colleges with lunch in an Oxford Country Mansion and a tour of Blenheim Palace. For the less adventurous there is a half-day tour in old London, including the dock area, the Tower of London Museum and the old Norman church of St. Bartholomew-the-Great. Accompanying guests are offered tours to Greenwich, the Wallace Collection of Art in the 18th century Hertford House mansion, and the Palace of Hampton Court, sometime residence of Henry VIII and the birthplace of Edward VI.

The 17th International Congress of Life Assurance Medicine promises to be an outstanding experience for all attendees.
